

What we've done so far



PEBL Skills Cafe

Between January 2017 and September 2022 the Skills Café have helped 1,336 residents; 247 have got jobs and 363 attended training courses



PEBL Money Advice Service

Between 2016 and 2020, Prospect residents saved £267,000 through our Money Advice service covering banking, budgets and benefits



PEBL Internet Café

Between 2014 and 2019, 198 people used the PEBL Internet Café to get online, learn new skills and stay in touch with family and friends



PEBL Unsafe to Safe Program

We ran a youth program between 2016 and 2018 to help 35 vulnerable young people aged 13 to 25 move to a place of safety in their lives



We've been running fortnightly Knit and Natter sessions since March 2017 to connect folks together; the ladies have even run MacMillan coffee mornings!



Between 2017 and 2019 we ran an after-school reading club for children from Cherrywood School to help them improve their reading

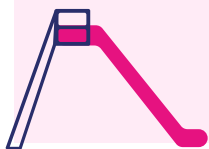
PEBL Well-being sessions

We ran a series of 6 Wellbeing sessions in 2018 to help people learn practical ways to feel better. In October 2022 we held a Wellbeing Health and Happiness Day



Moor Road Recreation Ground

PEBL contributed £97,000 towards the wow factor playground, multi gym equipment and cycle pump track in Moor Road Park for all to enjoy



PEBL Benches Project

We've installed 16 benches around the estate plus put in 4 picnic tables and seats at Moor Road Park for the community to have a well earned rest



PEBL Tree Project

Together with Rushmoor Borough Council we've taken out 17 problem trees and planted 27 more suitable new trees in their place; with another 37 coming soon!



PEBL Signage

We've put in three 'Welcome to the Prospect Community' signs at the entrances to the estate with artwork designed by local school children



We've awarded 27 grants totalling £16,682 since 2015 to community projects directly benefitting Prospect estate residents

PEBL Days Out



We took 18 school children to Runways End in October 2021 for an activity day doing archery, caving and climbing. In September 2022 we took 47 people to the seaside!

PEBL Litter Picks

We've run 4 Community Litter Picks and supported others run by MCP and Cove Brook Greenway Group to help clean up our estate

We ran a Family Fun Day at Cherrywood School in 2015 with nearly 300 people attending a variety of fun learning activities families could do together



PEBL Best Front Garden Competition

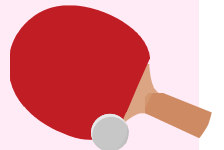
We ran a Best Front Garden Competition from 2015 to 2018 with Rushmoor in Bloom to see residents brighten up the estate with their colourful front gardens
